

Local Board of Appeal and Equalization

The Local Board of Appeal and Equalization meeting is held for property owners to review and comment on their property valuation and classification for the following years property taxes. This meeting looks at the estimated market value of the property and classification. The values are determined by the Wright County Assessor based on sales and market trends. The timeline for the property value used to determine taxes for 2025 is based on the sales and market trends from October 1, 2022 to September 30, 2023 and finalized by July 1, 2024.

Property owners can appeal the estimated market value or classification if they believe the property is Classified improperly or valued higher or lower than what the property owner believes they could sell the property for. Property Owners cannot appeal their amount of property tax due.
